

Moving beyond twelve

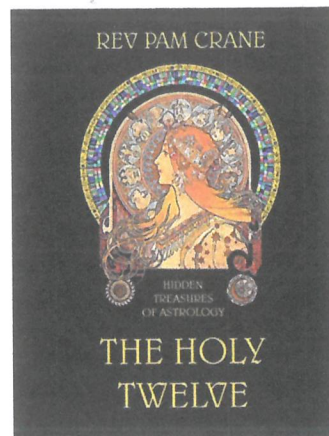
I am not a traditional astrologer, but don’t stop reading. I am an astrologer of the future, and the perspectives offered in this article are intended to help move our astrological understanding into the future as well. This piece is intended to move all of us beyond the limitations of the number twelve (twelve planets, twelve signs, twelve houses, etc.) and all the subdivisions and micro-divisions of continuing divisions into twelve energies. The planets and dwarf planets that science continues to discover are also encouraging astrological understanding and movement beyond the limits of a system based on twelve. As Pam Crane so beautifully pointed out in her *Astrological Journal* extract in November-December 2019 issue from her book titled *The Holy Twelve: Hidden Treasures of Astrology*:

“Twelve has been embedded in human culture for millennia, possibly originating in Mesopotamian civilisation – whence, of course, came the Chaldeans. Not ten, not decimals – despite the ten digits on the human (and simian) hand. Twelve.”

But that is my point. How limiting are our current beliefs? A system that is completely embedded in ancient and current human consciousness leaves little room for exploration of new concepts. We need to stretch our astrological muscles to grow. Perhaps we should consider the discovery of so many other heavenly bodies as a cosmic invitation to think more outside our current traditional ideas.

Pleiadian-Earth Energy Astrology does not use the number twelve in its assessment of energetic movement, although twelve is highly respected. It is appreciated as an energy that represents understanding. And thus, astrologers have based centuries of practice on divisions into twelve in hopes of deepening personal and cosmic understanding.

Now it’s time to move forward in our thinking and in our evaluation of the energies with which we work. Pleiadian-Earth Energy Astrology brings forth the importance of the



number thirteen...not because there are thirteen planets, houses or signs, but because thirteen is an energy of *integration* that allows us to assimilate all that we have learned and understood in studying our systems of twelve. Without that powerful pause to integrate, we are stuck in cycles and loops that view the world only through the lens of divisions into twelve

and further subdivisions using the same number. Integration (thirteen) is the space, the pause, the breath that allows us to integrate everything we know, giving it time to sink in, before we explore something new – which usually begins with a new cycle of twelve.

It is essential in studying ourselves, others, and our personal or joint experiences that we allow possibilities never before considered. If we try to box everything and everyone into a system that has previously provided the best explanations for human behaviours and timing, we are missing the very nature of evolutionary movement. We can’t think about or know what else is possible if we are focused only upon the energy of twelve, no matter how many subdivisions of twelve we fit into that box.

Not only does thirteen’s energy of integration help us to better understand ourselves and our place in the universe, it is also a point of connection to nature here on Earth. The energy of thirteen demands that we slow down enough so that we can realise that we are part of nature and so that we can make more conscious choices, reflecting an awareness of our connection to everything. With the recognition and use of the energy of thirteen, we begin to live our lives making choices that always consider the highest good for all. Doesn’t the world need that?

Would not that type of behaviour insure our evolutionary development as a species? And if we are to develop in this way, is it not necessary to move beyond traditional, old ways of looking at the world by expanding our understanding? The pause – the integration – offered by the thirteenth energy offers us the missing link to peace, cooperation, balance, and true unconditional love for all.

So, why thirteen?

Life is not organised into neat parcels of twelve units. A couple of related examples can make it clear that we are ignoring the actual reality around us: 1. the Moon cycles around the earth thirteen times in one of our Gregorian, artificially organised twelve-month years; and 2. most women have thirteen bleeding cycles within a Gregorian year. So why does everything in our lives continue to be based upon divisions of twelve, instead of thirteen? Some might argue that the Chaldeans began it this way, and we are honouring a time-proven system. The Chaldeans used the seven planets that were visible in the sky at that time. They also began each new day at sunset, which is something Pleiadian-Earth Energy Astrology offers. We have long since moved beyond the seven visible planets, adding the influences of other planets and dwarf planets into our cherished astrology, as science has discovered them. And yet, we changed our 'calendar date' markings to midnight when the Gregorian calendar took the place of ancient marking of days by the sun. It seems that we are trying to do two things at once with modern astrology – honour the discovery of new planetary influences yet discard the timing that made astrology work to begin with!

Our astrology would be much stronger, much more insightful, and much more helpful, if we simply honoured the *true* timing related to our own sun, rather than the artificial time that has been thrust upon us by a patriarchal society. There's a lot more I could say about this (and have, in my book *Sacred Retreat – Using Natural Cycles to Recharge Your Life*, published by Rochester, VT: Bear and Company, 2017). But the point is, we need to re-integrate the energy of thirteen (called 'Lucky Women's Number' in ancient days in direct relationship to women's times of integration, vision and inspiration) into our astrological practice. Many of our clients seek our guidance because their lives simply are not working. Culturally, without knowing or understanding why, we have become a society that pushes to accomplish more and more, to control more and more, without understanding the necessity of rest and integration of experience before moving on to the next project or objective.

What should take place for our own growth is an automatic pause to integrate previous learning before beginning the next cycle, just what the energy of thirteen offers.

Some examples of numbers' cosmic energies

To understand the value and purpose of Pleiadian-Earth Energy Astrology, one must understand that the cosmic energy of each number is different. Let me give you a few examples. The energy of the number one is all about initiation and beginnings. (You could compare this to 1st-house energy or the beginning energy of the sign of Aries.) However, in the Pleiadian-Earth Energy system, we have the opportunity to begin again *every thirteen days!* The second day brings the energy of two, giving us dualistic perspectives and an opportunity to see things differently. The energy of three brings creativity; four brings the building of a foundation, and then five brings a chance to change, in case our foundation is not exactly as we want it to be. And so on until we reach the twelfth energy, the energy of understanding.

Here we may finally understand the bits and pieces we have gathered in this thirteen-day cycle. As we progress along any thirteen-day period, from initiation to integration, we have the opportunity to build upon the day's previous energy, and the day before that, until we reach the precious point of integration on the thirteenth day. This is our natural place of slowing down, considering what we have experienced, and then preparing for a new start the next day.

My book *Pleiadian-Earth Energy – Charting the Spirals of Consciousness* (Bear and Company, 2018) and the accompanying 2022 *Pleiadian-Earth Energy Calendar* explain the system in much more detail. **(For the 2022 calendar, visit the website: laarkmaa.com/pleiadian-earth-energy-calendar.)** *The Astrological Journal* featured an in-depth excerpt from the above referenced book in the March-April 2019 issue, showing how this system helps provides distinct levels of evolution and growth in human consciousness.

Pleiadian-Earth Energy Astrology also does a great job of prediction. It's not a part of hoary astrology by any means. It provides a system for looking at both the cosmic and Earth influences at play on any given day with a simple glance at the calendar to make educated choices about how to proceed in one's life. It also provides clear indications of gifts and challenges (or opportunities for growth) in any relationship, if you know the other person's basic energetic make-up (something much easier to ascertain at a quick glance in this system.)

As an astrologer of the future, I am imploring each of you, whom I respect for all you know and all you offer, to consider what it could mean to the field of astrology to simply include an integration point into your calculations. Why keep astrology confined to ancient counting systems based on twelve, when an infinity of possibilities awaits us – if only we allow the time

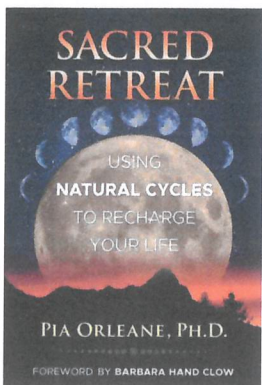
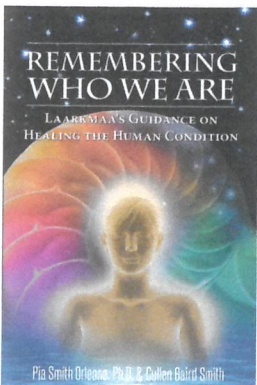
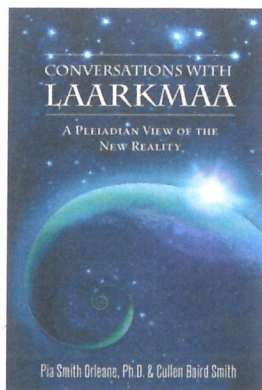
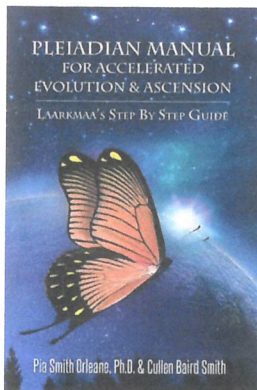
and space to integrate what we already know and listen for whatever is yet to come. Is it worth the chance to evolve by simply adding the energy of integration and amending old systems?

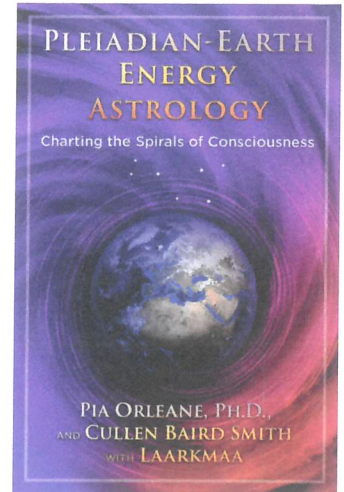

A short extract from Pia Orleane and Cullen Baird Smith's *Pleiadian-Earth Energy Astrology*

There are two major patterns of spiralling energy that constitute the foundation of our system. The first pattern is found in universal energies that relate to cosmic laws and cosmic truth. They reflect principles that are constants throughout the universe and are continually changing in the ways they manifest. There are thirteen universal energies, defined and explained in chapters 3 and 6. The second pattern is found in earth energies, which are the energies most relevant to our human proficiency. These energies are



more specific to our lives on Earth and they build upon one another, creating a non-hierarchical foundation for what comes next. Each contributes an important piece to understanding the whole of our earthly experience. Participation with these energies occurs at a lower or higher vibration, depending upon our choices and the development of our conscious awareness.

Pleiadian-Earth Energy Astrology is the only known system based on the cosmic energies that spiral (unnoticed) through the distinct levels of human consciousness. It is also alone in its use of the number thirteen as an integral player in understanding ourselves and our potential for evolution. Remarkably, this system instructs us in internally *and* externally expanding and integrating each level of our awareness. Once we understand and earnestly apply the intelligent guidance the cosmic energies offer, results follow naturally.

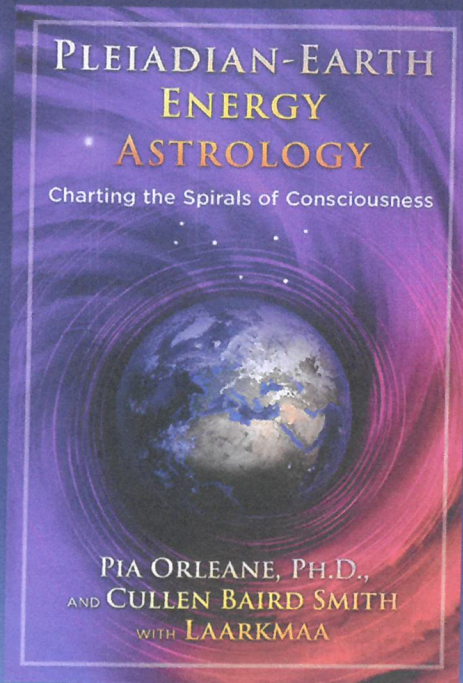
The Seven Sisters, as the stars of the Pleiades are sometimes called, are rarely used as guide points on astrological maps. 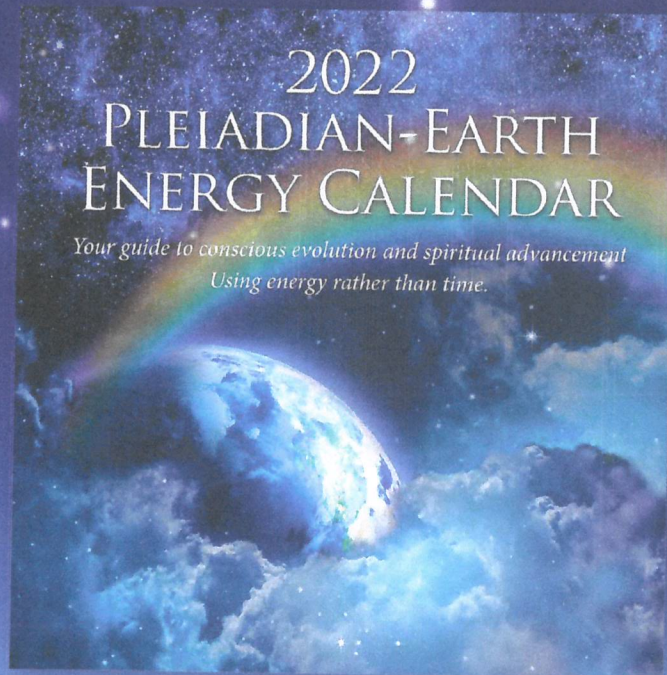
